


### HAS THE OPIOID CRISIS TOUCHED YOUR LIFE?

Statewide 54%, Capital Region 58% have been personally touched by opioid abuse\*






## HAS OPIOID-ABUSE GOTTEN WORSE?


In the past few years, has opioid abuse gotten worse, stayed the same or improved?





